Part 1

1. Luke 5:1-11 Christians Don’t Need To Fear Having Their Needs Met

- a. Jesus meets our needs as we trust and obey Him
 - i. Christians are called to work – 2 Thess 3:10
 - ii. God promises to care for us – Psalm 37:25-26 ***“I have been young, and now I am old: Yet I have not seen the righteous forsake, or his descendants begging for bread. All day long he is gracious and lends; and his descendants are a blessing.”***
 - iii. Consider:

 2. Paul’s words in 2 Corinthians 1:20
 3. God’s Word in Hebrews 4:14-15
- b. Jesus meets our needs in the darkest moments of our lives (John 21:1-14)
 - i. They thought their need was financial. Jesus knew their need was spiritual
 - ii. Gods says about finances:
 - iii. Malachi 3:8-12, ***“Will a man rob God? Yet you rob me.
“But you ask, ‘How do we rob you?’
“In tithes and offerings. ⁹ You are under a curse—the whole nation of you—because you are robbing me. ¹⁰ Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this,” says the LORD Almighty, “and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that you will not have room enough for it. ¹¹ I will prevent pests from devouring your crops, and the vines in your fields will not cast their fruit,” says the LORD Almighty. ¹² “Then all the nations will call you blessed, for yours will be a delightful land,” says the LORD Almighty.”***
 - iv. Romans 8:31-33, ***“What, then, shall we say in response to this? If God is for us, who can be against us? He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all—how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things? Who will bring any charge against those whom God has chosen? It is God who justifies.”***
